With airline approval, travelers can also bring up to two larger batteries (101-160 Wh) that weigh between 2-8 grams, complying with safety regulations. Power banks rated between 100 watt-hours (Wh) and 160Wh require airline approval.

Yes, you can bring a 20,000 mAh power bank on a plane. With a typical voltage of 3.7V, it has an approximate capacity of 74 Wh, which is well below the 100 Wh limit set by the FAA and TSA.

Yes, security can still ask questions, so carry printed or digital proof that shows your name, flight, power bank watt-hours and the airline contact who approved it.

Spare (uninstalled) lithium ion and lithium metal batteries, including power banks and cell phone battery charging cases, must be carried in carry-on baggage only.
