Overview

A small cell is basically a miniature base station that breaks up a cell site into much smaller pieces, and is a term that encompasses pico cells, micro cells, femtocells and can comprise of indoor/outdoor systems. Small cells are low-powered cellular radio access nodes that have ranges from around 10 meters to a few kilometers. They can provide high data rates by being deployed densely to achieve high spatial spectrum efficiency. [1] In the United. A small cell base station is a type of wireless communication infrastructure that is designed to enhance network capacity and coverage, particularly in areas with high user density or where traditional macrocell base stations face challenges. Ideal for densely populated environments like venues, residential streets, crowded commercial areas, and cities, small cells work seamlessly with macro cells to increase. 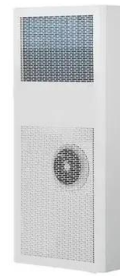
